Voluntary Local Reports - an innovative and participatory way for monitoring progress on SDG11 in cities

Summary

The cities of Niterói and Rio de Janeiro (Brazil) along with Trujillo and Chimbote (Peru) conducted voluntary local reports as part of the project “Accountability Systems for Measuring, Monitoring and Reporting on Sustainable City Policies in Latin America”, coordinated by UN-Habitat and the Economic Commission for Latin America and the Caribbean (ECLAC). La Paz in Bolivia conducted its local report in 2018. The aforementioned reports highlight their progress towards the achievement of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and specifically on the progress regarding SDG11 between 2015 and 2019. The Agenda 2030 is based on an integrated fourfold approach, including (1) the declaration of the global vision and shared principals, (2) the Sustainable Development Goals and targets and (3) the implementation phase followed by a (4) follow-up and report process. This structure highlights the crucial role cities and local governments play in achieving sustainable urban development through working towards sustainable urbanization and monitoring their progress at the local level. During the production of the report and the monitoring phase, an inclusive and participatory approach has been applied, with city authorities and other related stakeholders at the subnational level having been involved in the process. The cities are focusing on ten different areas related to the report process and the implementation of SDG11, including:

- the methodology and process for the preparation of the report;
- the challenges and bottlenecks faced by cities in the implementation of the SDGs;
- the incorporation of SDGs into the local frameworks and the intersection of local, regional and global frameworks;
- indicators for the SDG 11 targets and the projects undertaken to achieve them;
- means of implementation of SDG 11;
- the four dimensions of sustainable development;
- the incorporation of the ‘leaving no-one behind’ principle into local strategies;
- institutional mechanism and regulatory frameworks;
- monitoring and evaluation process at the subnational level;
- lessons learned and the way forward.

The presentation of the local reports will provide answers to the following: I. How different stakeholders at the local level contribute substantially to achieving the Global Goals; II. How local reports support the structure of the Agenda 2030 through monitoring and evaluation at the local level and support national report processes; III. How innovation and technologies can enhance data collection and analysis at the local level.
