Summary

In 2015 at the 70th International United Nations General Assembly, the 2030 Agenda to achieve Sustainable Development Goals for the future of the world and the well-being of the people was adopted. In 2016 there was a follow-up New Urban Agenda adopted at the 3rd United Nations Conference on Housing and Sustainable Urban Development (Habitat III) held in Quito. Beyond the social, economic and environmental areas which are the main roots of the sustainability, the issue of the governance is now deeply at the heart of the achieving device the SDGs and application of the urban agenda to ensure that "nobody is left behind". If these different agendas are adopted and implemented by the States, it is hoped that there will be tangible, measurable results with real impact on the populations in both cities and territories by 2030. Indeed Resilient and sustainable cities require the participation and commitment of all actors and components of the community in the design, planning and governance of cities and territories. To be sustainable, the governance of cities also implies a good management of the cultural dimension in the construction of systems, an adaptation of practices, approaches and tools of governance to the context of cities and territories, a better support for specificities local culture to consider, values, principles important in the context. Enda ECOPOP will organize this networking sessions to share experiences, practices, and innovations in the localization of SDGs, attempted in different cultural contexts across Africa, Asia, Latin America and Europe. After the opening presided over by the Minister of Urban Planning of Senegal, the networking session will be introduced in two stages. The first is reserved for four cities to share their experiences: - City of Barcelona (Spain) - City of Matola (Mozambique) - Kaolack Departmental Council (Senegal) - City of Porto Alégre (Brazil), - City of Gwangju (South Korea). The second plateau will be reserved for organizations supporting cities and human settlements: - The Committee on Social Inclusion and Participatory Democracy of UCLG (Spain), - International Observatory of Participatory Democracy for the Africa Region (Senegal), - Chonnam National University (South Korea) - Center for Social Studies (Portugal),
