This event will be dedicated to the discussion of how an integrated transition towards a circular economy in cities is able to change the ways we are thinking about jobs. Therefore, it will look at the environmental and socio-economic impact of the transition to a circular economy, as well as its impact on the culture of work. During the discussion, participants will learn how circular economy jobs can be a proxy indicator of well-being and the overall circularity transition in cities. The panel will give insights into cities' challenges, from employment issues and environmental issues and the relation to the circular economy. The session also aims to present how UNEP, Circle Economy and ICLEI collaborated to develop the 8 pilot projects and the circular economy jobs methodology.
