The event will bring together leaders of relevant women's and youth's groups, grassroots, at international, regional and local levels, several regional governments, activists, researchers and urban experts, to exchange on youth and women's practices and strategies for the promotion of the links between urbanization, culture and innovation as a basis for achieving inclusive, safe, resilient, peaceful and sustainable cities and human settlements. The pandemic crisis has made evident the pending issues and the structural problems of sustainability. For this reason, it is not possible to propose old recipes, but it is necessary to experiment with new paths and identify new subjects to guide them. The participants in the event will discuss the new words necessary to interpret places, contexts, needs, in an innovative way, to build a grammar with which to structure actions for cities that change the quality of life of the people who live in them. The event aims, thus, at enriching the ongoing construction of a new GRAMMAR and an ABCD for the implementation of the New Urban Agenda and the achievement of the urban goals of the 2030 Agenda.
